Rev. Brittany Hesson is most recently from Louisville, Kentucky and is the oldest of four (4) siblings. Brittany graduated from Hopkinsville High School, KY in 2008. She went on to earn her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Business Management/Entrepreneurship from Murray State University, KY in 2011 and her Master of Business Administration from Murray State University in December 2014.

Brittany was first introduced to the PC(USA) by her freshman college roommate, who had the car to drive to church. Shortly after joining the local campus ministry, she also decided to join First Presbyterian Church in Murray through baptism on her 18th birthday in March 2009. By the time she left Murray to attend seminary in 2015, Brittany had been ordained as a ruling elder, served as church custodian, campus ministry director, choir member, youth director, nursery attendant, worship leader, church office administrative assistant, and VBS director.

The Presbytery of Western Kentucky took her under care as a pastoral candidate for ordination. Brittany enrolled at Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Louisville, KY in fall 2015, where she served as Student Body Representative, Clerk, and President during her first, second, and third years, respectively.
